

## Save on Your Energy Bills

**If you're having trouble finding the money to make your home more energy efficient, there's help.**

If you

- own your own single- or double-wide mobile home; or
- own and live in a house with a combined building and land assessed value (before exemptions) of \$80,000 or less; or
- currently participate in the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP); or
- have received General Assistance from the Town in the past year;

then you can receive an **\$1,050 Energy Upgrade Bundle** including a professional energy assessment and a number of basic weatherization improvements with as little as **\$50 out of pocket**. These improvements save energy and money year after year.

**Rebates are also available for those who don't qualify for this low income program.** There are discounts on insulation projects and ductless heat pumps and wood and pellet stoves, making your home more comfortable and affordable year-round.
